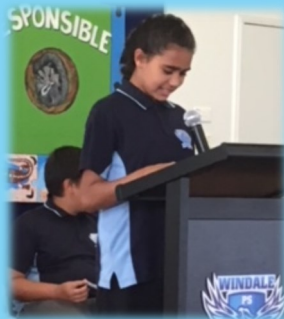
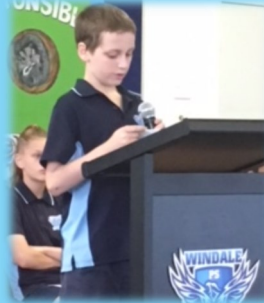
It was decided that each year they would evaluate the previous year's concert and try to come up with new ideas. One suggestion was a Christmas poem.


