Expectations for a Student Leader at Windale Public School in 2019.

- Encourage students to take pride in their school;
- Assist any student in need when necessary;
- Willingly help teachers and the community.

To be considered as a suitable candidate for becoming a Student Leader at Windale Public School in 2019, you must satisfy the following criteria. Use the checklist below to support your leadership goals as a Student Leader in 2019.

I have consistently high attendance at school.	
I have been permitted to attend all school PBL reward days commencing Semester 2.	
I always follow the school's expectations of being a Safe, Respectful and Responsible Learner in the classroom, playground and community.	
I engage in events and activities that encourage the development of collaborative community learning. For example, school debating team, cross country.	
I can maintain acceptable standards of work and behaviour in class and school activities with a positive attitude towards all learning.	
I look for opportunities to lead by example e.g. show respect towards all staff and peers.	
I am able to encourage others as they work on activities and projects.	
I display persistence and resilience when undertaking a more difficult task.	
I consistently wear my whole school uniform with pride.


